• Violation #1: Immed	liate phone call or other form of contact will be made to the parent to alert them of their child's
behavior. At the next v	veekly meeting that the scout attends, the scout must be accompanied by a parent, who will be
responsible for superv	ising him during the entire meeting. The scout will also be counseled privately by the Scoutmaster
and/or the Troop Com	mittee on how he/she can correct his/her behavior and make better choices in the future.
• Violation #2: The sco	out will be suspended from the Troop and all functions for two (2) weeks.
Violation #3: If found	to be in violation a third time, the scout will be counseled by the Scoutmaster and additional
	roop committee to discuss his/her future membership in Troop 193. At that time further
consequences will be a	assigned, which may include a long-term suspension, or revocation of membership.
If the Scout is serving in a	position of leadership, removal from that position may also occur.
Theft of Property (Troop o	r personal) – This is a crime and will lead to automatic revocation of troop membership.
